

LEGIONELLA AWARENESS



Overview

This course will provide delegates with an understanding of the risks that Legionella brings, as well as the skills required to develop systems and working practices to protect against it. L8 Approved Code of Practice stipulates that all 'responsible people' on a site are to be suitably trained, so this course is designed for those whose job role includes maintenance activities. Equipping personnel with the correct skills are essential for safe, legal and effective management of water systems, and is key to preventing water-based diseases.

Assessment
